District 20 Junior Division Rules Fall 2019



The following modifications of Little League Baseball Official Regulations and Playing Rules have been adopted as "Local Rules" for the District 20 Junior Division Fall Ball Season.

Purpose of "Fall Ball" is to operate as a training and developmental season:

- 1. ROSTERS: Rosters shall consist of players ages 12-15 years old based on the 2020 Age Chart.
- 2. Teams with less than 9 players may borrow players from the opposing team or another team in the District. The player must be a registered player. (Pitching/Catching rules for players playing in more than one game in a day must be followed)
- 3. No score or standings will be kept and therefore no protests
- 4. Pitchers are allowed to pitch a maximum of two (2) innings per game.
- 5. All players shall be listed and bat in the batting lineup, whether in the field defensively or not
- 6. No player can be off the field when his/her team plays defensively for a second inning in a game unless all other players have been or are off the field for one inning.
- 7. A Maximum of 3 adult coaches (Manager + up to 2 coaches) are allowed before and during the game. One adult must remain in the dugout once the game has started. If a manager or coach is ejected, he is not replaceable and you must play with one less coach. If he was the only coach, the game must be suspended until a later date.
- 8. The Official Pitch Counter will be notified of all pitching changes and advised of the age of the incoming pitcher.
- 9. Game times will be no new innings after 2 hours 15 min, completing any inning that was started.
- 10. The inning shall end when three outs are recorded or the offensive team has batted all players in their lineup, whichever comes first.
- 11. The home team is responsible for pitch count. It is recommended that both teams keep track and verify after each inning.
- 12. Each pitcher will get one warning per game with regards to balks before runners advance.
- 13. Manager/Coach/Player Ejections: The penalty for a manager ejection is immediate removal and a one game suspension the next game for that person. The ejected person is not allowed at the venue for his next scheduled game. Please make note in the scorebook of the ejection. It is the responsibility of the manager and/or Division Rep to notify District 20 personnel of any ejections. The penalty for not notifying the proper personnel is an additional game suspension or suspension of the Manager.
- 14. Home team is responsible for supplying baseballs and an umpire for each game. (Due to the no score or standings being kept

District Ground Rules



Glendora National- South Hills: Any ball that rolls or lands on the asphalt area in left field is considered a Ground Rule Double. A player with a batting helmet and glove must protect any pitcher warming up in the bull pen areas during the game or infield practice. Any fly ball must clear only the metal fence portion of the outfield fence (in fair territory) to be considered a HR.

Claremont- Griffith Park: Any fly ball hitting the large tree in left field or hitting/landing over the sidewalk north of the tree is a home run. Any ground ball hitting the large tree in left field or hitting/landing over the sidewalk north of the tree is a ground rule double. All other batted balls hit in the rest of the outfield are "all you can get". Any ball hitting the overhang of the tree on the first base line is considered a dead ball.
